


WE ARE PART OF GOD'S CREATION

As we remember everything we know is from God, we give thanks for creation.




FROM CREATION TO A LEADER

Today we still pray for leaders with wisdom and compassion. Yet even as we pray, the garden of God's creation continues to bloom.




THE HOPE OF NEWNESS



We join the wise men in their wonder and astonishment.






SO, WE GO AND TELL
