Dear Friends in Christ,

Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel (Isaiah 7:14).

Happy New Year! By the time you read this, the Advent season will have begun. Advent is the beginning of the Church Year – it comes from the Latin Adventus, which means "coming." Advent is a time of preparation in the life of the church, when all Christians prepare for the coming of Christ.

To help you prepare, I encourage you to refer to the daily Scripture readings elsewhere in this newsletter. As you read, pray that God will reveal a message of anticipation and hope. Find a quiet time, perhaps with your morning coffee, or before you turn off your light each evening. This is a great time of the year to come closer to God in Christ.

This Advent, my sermons will consider the anticipation of the Messiah:

December 2: "Mixed Message?"

December 9: "Sending the Messenger"

December 16: "The Messenger Speaks"

December 18: "The Birth of a King"

We will spend time looking at ancient prophecies about the arrival of Jesus, the Messiah, the Anointed One. Through the ages, God has spoken about the coming of his beloved Son. Please make every effort to join us each Sunday.

Plan also to participate in the Living Nativity, December 7-8 – a MUP tradition is being revived, to bring the birth of Christ to the community. If you would like to help, please contact Alma Staskiewicz. Many hands make light work!

This is an exciting time in the life of our church. The Transition Team has been meeting in earnest – I hope you have read their letter. If you have questions or comments, please contact a Team member. We will soon post a Timeline of our history in the Tarry 'N' Talk area, to receive comments on key events from the past twenty-five years. Next, we will conduct a number of congregational surveys, both written and in conversation, to get the mood of the membership and to know where God is calling us.

Much work and many conversations need to take place before we elect a Pastor Nominating Committee. Before that, we need to discuss and answer the following questions:

Who is Mars U.P. Church today (not 25 or 50 years ago)? What is happening in our community? What do we as the Body of Christ want to accomplish in the next five years? What sort of pastor do we need to lead us into that future? My brothers and sisters, we WILL get there. Your next pastor is out there, but we need to be patient – *if we don't know who we are looking for, how will we know it when we find him or her*?

Maybe things are going slower than you like. Maybe you believe we should be reading resumes by now. Maybe you think the new pastor should be here already. The Interim Process, if done correctly, is sometimes difficult and time-consuming, but it is *necessary*. The timing is God's, not ours (or mine!) MUP is working through our past and our present, and looking to the future.

In the meantime, continue to be in prayer as we prepare – for the coming of Christ, and for a bright future at Mars Church. I continue to hold this great church, and all of you, in my prayers.

May God shower you with abundant blessings this Christmas, and in the New Year.


