MESSAGE FROM THE NEW CHI ALPHA MU COORDINATOR

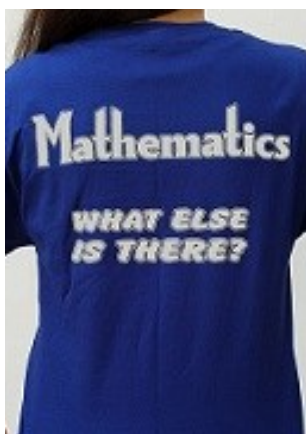

GRANTS:

Summer Grants are offered to support middle school students who will attend a summer math program. \$500 is made available for this grant.
