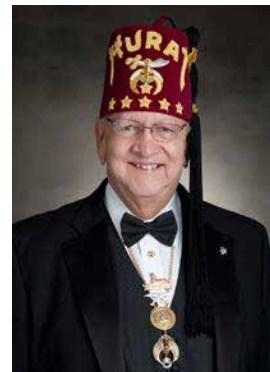

# Meeting Minutes\*

## **2013 Annual Meeting – June 30, 2013 Carribbean Cove – Indianapolis IN**

Meeting was called to order with all officers, (except Howard Helwig – absent due to medical leave) and eight Past Presidents in attendance. Visiting dignitaries were introduced. Total attendance included 68 members representing 17 Temples and a total of 30 votes. Individual officer and Treasurer reports were presented. Financials are in good shape and an audit review was conducted by officers and past presidents. IRS 990N has been filed and the fidelity bond is current.

Four rule and/or by-law items were brought to the membership and disposed of as follows:

1. Change to requirements re line candidates attendance at MidWinter Meetings - PASSED (attendance at MidWinter desired but not mandatory - candidate can identify self to Secretary Treasurer and then arrange for a committee of 3 officers to interview by phone or in person as can be arranged and report back).
2. Change to one vote per Unit vs Temple - DID NOT PASS
3. Allow web posting as valid communication vehicle - PASSED
4. Update Class 5 definition to make/model/color for "matched" units (years may vary along with minor standard equipment) - PASSED

New Business: Hi Point Trophy to Include Obstacle Course & Slow Race Scoring Beginning in 2014 PASSED - Specific Scoring Calculation to be discussed at Midwinter 2014 Meeting.

***(Follow on note from MidWinter Mtg Decision – Scoring for 2014 Hi Point Trophies will combine Drill and Obstacle Scores with a 75% Drill Weighting and 25% Obstacle Weighting with Slow Race Deferred)***

Discussion of adding a "Show Class" for cars, tractors, bikes etc was had and will be further discussed and decided at 2014 MidWinter meeting.

Election of Officers – Dennis H Green was elected Sergeant at Arms and all other officers were moved up one position and sworn in. H Helwig was sworn in subsequently as 2nd VP at MidAtlantic by PP Medd Boxx. At Captains and Judges meeting age brackets for Individual Age Competitions clarified as <50; 50-64 inclusive; 65+.

## **MidWinter Meeting - March 22, 2014 Shriners Hospital for Children – Houston TX**

President Jack Knight called the meeting to order at the SHC while the Ladies were given a tour of the facility. Invocations and pledge of allegiance were given as customary. In attendance – 16 members, 7 officers, 2 past presidents, 2 Imperials. 13 Temples were represented. All Officers were present along with Past Presidents Medd Box and Ardys Bennett. Visiting dignitaries included Carl Auvil, President TSMPA, Tooter McDonald, Imperial Sir Jim Cain and Imperial Chief Rabban Jerry Gantt, among others. President Jack Knight noted that IASMC is celebrating our 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and he presented a new design anniversary ball cap to the officers. Additional caps will be available for sale to units and at Imperial at a cost of \$15 each. Each officer gave a report of individual activities in attending various regional association meetings and competitions. Further discussion was had regarding the "Show Class" and it was decided by unanimous vote that this would be implemented in Minneapolis this summer. 2<sup>nd</sup> VP Howard Helwig will run this. This is an individual participation event. Requirement for entry is that the Noble be an active Shriner and have paid dues to IASMC. Entry classes will be ad hoc and divided based upon numbers and participation with categories such as classic cars, corvettes/mustangs, bikes, tractors or other novelty vehicles. The general intent is to draw all comers and refine as we grow. Evaluation will be based on fit & finish, uniqueness, cleanliness, vehicle presentation and knowledge. "Uniforms" are not per se required, but the Noble is expected to wear a FEZ when presenting his vehicle. In order to further support individual IASMC membership and participation in Obstacle and Slow race as well as Show Class it was moved, seconded and voted that the membership sections of our rules and bylaws be updated to remove the requirement that participants be members of a Unit and that they merely be required to be a member of good standing in their Temple. This was moved, seconded and voted unanimously and the members will be asked to ratify the above at the general business meeting in Minneapolis for immediate implementation. Noble Ed Raper, Sesostris Shriners, was in attendance at MidWinter and declared his candidacy for the Sergeant at Arms position to be voted at the July 6<sup>th</sup> General Session. President elect Danny Garcia announced the dates for the 2015 MidWinter meeting as March 19-22 in San Antonio, with 2015 Imperial to be in Houston with an Indoor Competition. The meeting was closed. The weekend included a great dinner at the historic Joe's BBQ and a wonderful outing to the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo – The World's Largest. Along with photo opportunities and entertainment by The Band Perry. A great time was had by all – and it should be noted that – as always – the MidWinter is a self sustained event and no dues or IASMC treasury funds are used for this meeting. We were assisted throughout the weekend by Ill. Kenneth Pierce, Past President TSMPA along with Past Potentate Sharon Temple and his Lady Virginia – a special thank you is warranted for all their hard work and efforts. Your Texas Hospitality was Huge.
