Common Sense Corner

- **SHEPHERD HOOKS**—Small shepherd hooks in the mulch area for hanging plants and bird feeders are permitted. For reference, anything small is 48 inches or below.
- **PORCH & PATIOS**—No recreational implements, lawn furniture, toys or other similar articles should be placed or parked on any of the Common Areas and facilities in except with accordance of Rules and Regulations. The Common Areas and facilities should be kept clean and clear of rubbish, debris and other unsightly material. No activity should be conducted on any part of the complex that is or might be unsafe, unsightly, unhealthy or hazardous to any person.
- **SIGNS**—No signs may be displayed in your yard, mulched area, or on the outside of your unit. This includes, but is not limited to For Sale signs, political signs and security signs. Please place the these signs inside of front windows.
- **CHARCOAL GRILLS** — When using a charcoal grill, cool coals should be discarded properly. Do not discard in the common area. This includes the drainage areas.
- **TRASH CANS** — Trash pickup is every Monday (if Holiday, the following day) by Waste Management. The garbage containers can be put out on Sunday evenings and must be returned to the garage no later than Tuesday Noon. Non-compliance is subject to fines. See the Rules and Regulations.
- **NO PARKING ON THE GRASSY AREAS** — We are having a problem with people parking on the street and it is destroying the grass, which in turn costs money to repair. Please remember parking on the streets is a towable offense (at owner's expense).
- **ADDITIONS OR CHANGES**—If you want to make any changes, please fill out and submit the architectural review form. The board will review the request and either approve/decline the request.
