Pastor's Corner

Well, my friends, I'm another year older (*my birthday is in pretty close to Christmas – as the sweater with Jesus smiling on it says: “All the cool people are born in December” – tongue in cheek of course*). But even though I'm older, I still feel the Christmas spirit! I'm glad Christmas lasts into the new year (and not just so I can keep the tree up longer). I expressed something at our congregational meeting on 12/21, but I want to share it here for any who weren't able to be present. I want to *intentionally and sincerely* say thank you for the support you have shown Wiebke and me over the last year – it is a great blessing to serve such a loving church – and there are a great many ways you manifest that – *I see it, acknowledge it, and appreciate it*. You have shown great love to me – in a myriad of ways (materially, emotionally, and spiritually). And I feel great love for you.

I also want to thank the leaders who give of themselves throughout the year – the church officers on the Session & Deacons, the staff that are *amazing* co-workers, and the leaders of the committees and ministry teams. I know you sacrifice a great deal and you might feel that your work sometimes goes unnoticed. I notice it, trust me. In fact, I know what it feels like to be overtaxed and stretched too thin.

As a gesture of solidarity with those who have labored for the Lord, I want to take this opportunity to ask every person who is part of Puckety's church family, to be open to the REAL possibility – no, the LIKELIHOOD - that God is calling you to a form of service. There are important areas where your giftedness is being called for, *by the Lord*. The Nom. Committee is discerning the next class of Elders & Deacons. If you are asked, at the very least you should sincerely pray about it. I wasn't going to serve as a GA commissioner; I almost said “no” right off, but then I remembered how Moses balked at God, and tried to wiggle out of God's call on his life. Make no mistake: God is calling some of you ... some to be Elders ... some to be Deacons ... some to serve on ministry teams like Discipleship & Children's Church, Outreach, Upkeep, and A/V, because EVERY single one of these teams not only needs additional hearts, hands and minds, but leaders. There are major opportunities to step up.

Have you ever heard a preacher say: “The all-powerful, all-sufficient God doesn't ‘need’ us, BUT He *invites* us!” And I am confident that others in Christ's Body here at Puckety need you; because *I* do. Every single committee and ministry team needs those who will answer the call, including those who think they don't have the *time* ... or don't have the *talent* ... or don't have the *energy* ... or the *know-how*. Moses, and a lot after him, thought they didn't have what it took either. I'm *not* a burning bush, but as your pastor, I can sense the Holy Spirit urging all of us to take off our sandals, because we're on holy ground ... God has something to say to us ... God has a mission for us ... God has a plan in store. Let's be ready to say, “Here I am. Use me.” Here's to following the ever-faithful God in the New Year.

The Puckety Church Board of Deacons is pleased to share an update on the recent Samaritan's Purse international outreach. The congregation made generous contributions to all three featured projects. At our December meeting, the following amounts were reported:

- \$240 for "Bring Clean Water to a Community" (Clean Water Project)
- \$240 for "Help a Poor Farming Family" (Farm and Garden Project)
- \$100 for "Send a New Missionary Doctor" (New Missionary Doctor Project)
- \$1,055 designated for any of the three projects, which was divided equally among them.

Additionally, the Deacons decided to increase their support by "rounding up" donations, resulting in:

- \$600 allocated to the Clean Water Project
- \$600 allocated to the Farm and Garden Project
- \$500 allocated to the New Missionary Doctor Project

Grace Presbyterian Church received a total of 26 shoe boxes from Puckety for Operation Christmas Child. These donations will be distributed to children globally and are expected to have a meaningful impact. We appreciate your contribution, and the positive difference it will make.

Discipleship Essentials Small Group

Here is the tentative schedule of topics – please feel free to ask questions! Please be committed to make at least 7 of the meetings. Wednesdays from **6:30 PM to 8:00 PM** – try to arrive 5 to 10 min. early each week, so we can pray, start on time and end on time. We will **not** be covering every chapter in the book (there are 25), so I encourage you to start now, if you can, and do a few of the opening chs. (1-4) in advance of our first meeting. We will be starting with ch. 5.

1st Meeting (1/28) – Introduction & Ch. 5 (*Prayer*) – please have read & completed the sections on pages 32-39. We will review and discuss.

2nd Meeting (2/4) - *Worship* (ch. 6) – have completed before our meeting: pages 40-46. We will review and then discuss questions on p. 47-48.

NOTE – We will meet in Pastor Brian's OFFICE b/c Deacons in Conf. Rm.

3rd Meeting – (2/11) *Made in God's Image* (ch. 8) + some of chapter 9 (*Sin*) – use same pattern for the pages/questions to complete prior to meeting (*ongoing*).

4th Meeting – (2/25) Finish *Sin* (ch. 9) and also chapter 10 (*Grace*) – Reformed theme

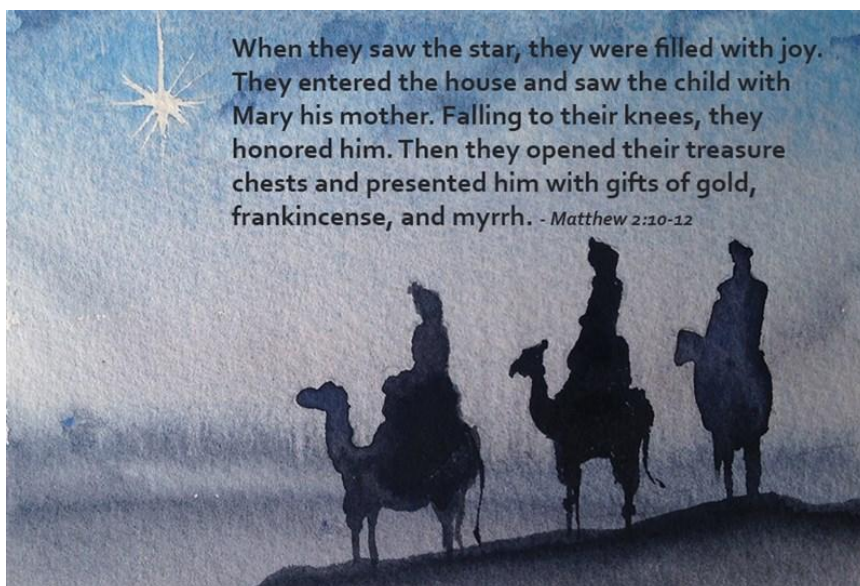




LOWER BURRELL'S CHRISTMAS IN THE WOODS
