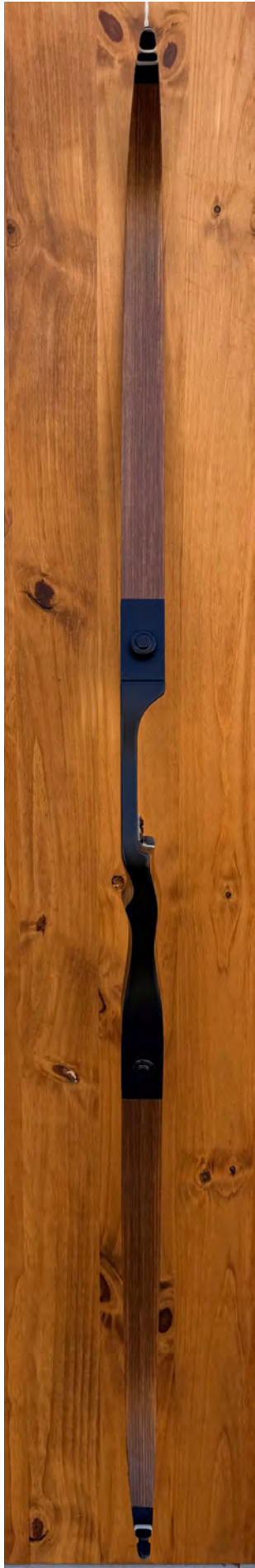

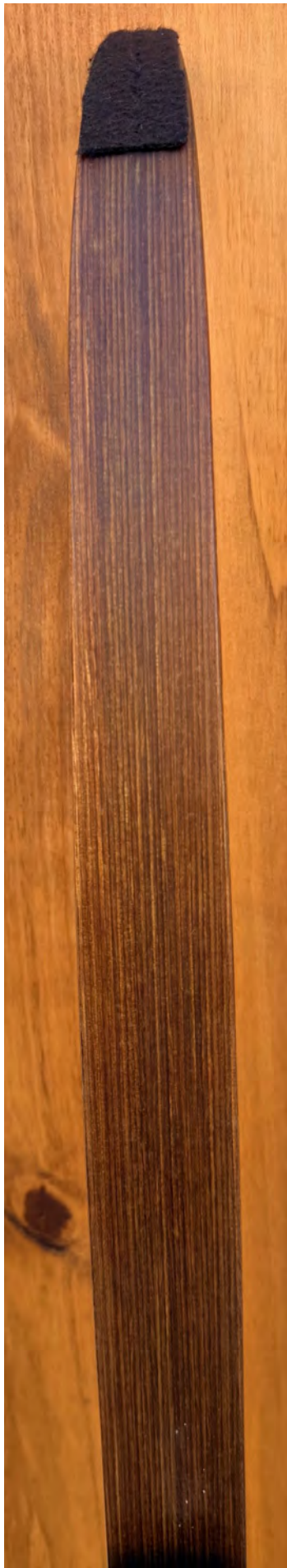

DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing takedown recurve designed by Early Hoyt Jr. When you hold it, the first thing you'll notice is the craftsmanship and high quality. The Skyhawk was one of the fastest TD bows ever produced in the 90's. The riser is substantial and fairly heavy. Comfortable grip. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. This bow is in near pristine condition. Decal is in excellent shape. Comes with a rug rest and side plate as shown, and a new string. Also includes matching WNS limb covers.

This bow sold new for \$440 in 1992, which translates to \$1,016 in 2025 inflation adjusted dollars. Skyhawk's currently sell in the \$400-\$700 range, depending on condition. This one is discounted due to it's relatively high draw weight (65#).
