- KIMBALL PARK FALLS - West Branch Montreal River (Hurley): 10 feet
- ROCK CUT FALLS - West Branch Montreal River (Hurley): 15 feet
- GILE FALLS - West Branch Montreal River (Gile): 15 feet
- SPRING CAMP FALLS - East Branch Montreal River (Hurley): 20 feet
- SUPERIOR FALLS - Montreal River (Lake Superior): 90 feet
- POTATO RIVER FALLS (3 falls) - Potato River (Gurney): 90 feet
- WHEN FALLS - Tyler Forks River (Gurney): 15 feet
- FOSTER FALLS - Potato River (Gurney): 25 feet
- LAKE OF THE FALLS - Turtle River (Mercer): 10 feet
- RICE LAKE FALLS - Turtle River (Mercer): 10 feet
- SHAY'S DAM FALLS - Turtle River (Mercer): 15 feet
- ROUSE FALLS - Rouse Creek (Upson): 15 feet
- LITTLE BALSAM FALLS - Tyler Forks River (Upson): 8 feet
- SAXSON FALLS - Montreal River (Lake Superior): 78 feet
- UPSON FALLS - Potato River (Upson): 18 feet

Off Trail Boondocking Riding Do's and Don'ts

- Do** Ride only on County Forest logging roads and skid trails that are not gated, signed or bermed. Riding through the forest, between trees is not allowed.
- Do** Respect Private landowner rights and know where you are at all times.
- Do** Registration and legal equipment is required to access County Forest land.
- Do** Ride with GPS, map, proper snowmobile & Emergency Equipment.
- Do** Understand that snow can be very deep and temperatures especially at night can drop to dangerous levels.
- Do** Ride at own Risk.
- Do** Enjoy our beautiful county and treat as it were your own.
- Do** Have a Great Snowmobile Experience & Please come Back.
- Do** Come back as many times as you would like!
- Don't** assume a track in the snow is on County Land.
- Don't** ride on Iron County trails for x-country, skiing, snowshoeing.
- Don't** agitate wildlife.
- Don't** expect cell phone service.
- Don't** leave garbage in the forest.
- Don't** ride alone.
- Don't** ride on power company established right of ways.
- Don't** wreck this opportunity for everyone by not following the rules.
