### TOWN OF GREENWOOD PERMIT & INSPECTION PROCEDURES

- 1. Applicant must fill out the application completely.
- 2. All fees must be paid to the Town of Greenwood and Steve Grayson before the permit can be issued.
- 3. The application is not the permit.
- 4. State license number must be checked with Louisiana State Licensing Board
- 5. Residential new, addition & remodel permits cannot be issued until the plan review is complete.
- 6. Commercial new, addition & remodel permits cannot be issued until the plan review is complete and a fire marshal letter has been provided.
- 7. A copy of all permits must be provided to Steve Grayson. Receipt attached to the permit.
- 8. All inspection request and any other questions must be called in to Steve Grayson (318-426-4992). Special time and appointments can be requested to make the inspection. All inspections will be made within 48 hours of the inspection request.
- 9. On new, additions and remodel permits; electrical, plumbing, mechanical & building inspections will be made at the same time.
- 10. The following inspections are required:

### ELECTRICAL

Saw Service

- 1<sup>st</sup> under slab (concrete encased electrode and under slab conduit)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Wall rough
- $3^{rd}$  final

Temporary Power (trench depth if applicable)

# MECHANICAL

- 1<sup>st</sup> rough (supply, return, exhaust & outside air duct), condensate pipe
- $2^{nd}$  final (unit placement, duct pressure test, final connections)

# PLUMBING

- $1^{ST}$  under slab with pressure test on drain & water pipe
- $2^{nd}$  wall rough (pressure test on water pipes and gas pipes), main vent thru roof
- 3<sup>rd</sup> final (fixture connection of all drain, vent, water and gas piping)

# BUILDING

 $1^{st}$  – foundation (footing depth and width, slab thickness & elevation, vapor barrier, rebar placement)

 $2^{nd}$  – wall rough (stud spacing, king & jack studs, headers, ceiling joists, roof rafters and supports, roof decking, wall insulation, bracing & vapor barrier)  $3^{rd}$  - final
