

# Bloomfield Police Department

## Monthly Report for February 2017

This is the monthly report for the Month of February 2017 from the Bloomfield Police Department. It is the police department's goal to keep the citizens of Bloomfield Township/Village informed as to the police department's activities, statistics, and community projects. It is very important that the citizens be aware of the various concerns that have and are occurring within our community.

On Saturday, February 11<sup>th</sup> at approximately 3:10pm officers responded to a residence on Center Drive for a disorderly subject complaint. At the conclusion of the investigation a 29-year-old male was arrested and confined in the Walworth County Jail for a probation violation.

On Wednesday, February 15<sup>th</sup> at approximately 8:05am officers responded to a theft from motor vehicle complaint on Myrtle Road. The complainant reported that persons unknown entered his vehicle and stole a compound bow and arrows. This theft remains under investigation.

On Wednesday, February 15<sup>th</sup> at approximately 9:32am officers assisted the Lake Geneva Police Department with a search warrant at an address on Golden Glow Road. While at the residence officers issued non-traffic citations for possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia.

On Wednesday, February 15<sup>th</sup> at approximately 12:24pm officers responded to a two vehicle personal injury crash in the area of Hyacinth Rd and Moss Road. At the conclusion of the investigation a 25-year-old female driver was issued traffic citations for failure to yield right of way/stop sign, operate motor vehicle without insurance and failure to notify DMV of address/name change. Additionally, charges of operating after revocation and ignition interlock device tampering/failure to install were forwarded to the Walworth County District Attorney's office.

On Saturday, February 18<sup>th</sup> at approximately 3:40pm officers assisted the Bloomfield-Genoa City Fire Department with a structure fire on Bloomfield Road. The fire was ultimately extinguished and there were not any injuries associated with this fire.

On Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> at approximately 2:31pm officers responded to a criminal damage to property complaint which occurred on Eau Claire Road. The complainant reported that person(s) unknown had "kicked out" the windshield of his vehicle while it was parked in the driveway. This incident remains under investigation.

On Friday, February 24<sup>th</sup> at approximately 10:30am officers responded to a report of a fire which had occurred to a detached garage overnight but had somehow been extinguished prior to being discovered. There was not anything suspicious noted during the investigation, the cause of the fire may have been weather related.

On Sunday, February 26<sup>th</sup> at approximately 2:20pm officers executed a traffic stop Hwy 12 for a speeding violation. At the conclusion of the traffic stop a 27-year-old male was issued a traffic citation for the speeding violation. Additionally the male was issued non-traffic citations for possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia.

During the month of February 2017 the Bloomfield Police Department responded to 739 calls for service compared to 975 calls for service during the month of February 2016. During the month of February 2017 the police department affected 85 arrests for various violations of Bloomfield Municipal Ordinances and Wisconsin State Statutes compared to 106 arrests during the month of February 2016.
