## **PROPOSALS THAT WILL APPEAR ON THE AUGUST 6, 2024 BALLOT**

### **TUSCOLA COUNTY RECYCLING RENEWAL**

Shall Tuscola County renew the current Recycling millage levy of .1500 mills (\$.15 for each \$1,000 of taxable value) upon the taxable value of property in Tuscola County, for a period of 8 years, 2025 through 2032, inclusive, to provide funds for recycling within Tuscola County? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage raises an estimated \$343,219 in the first calendar year after its approval. All revenue will be disbursed to Tuscola County and shall be exclusively used for recycling activities within Tuscola County.

### **TUSCOLA COUNTY SENIOR CITIZEN HOME DELIVERED MEALS**

Shall Tuscola County impose a new Senior Citizen Home Delivered Meal millage levy of 0.2000 mills (\$.20 per \$1,000 of taxable value) upon the taxable value of property in Tuscola County for a period of 5 years, 2025 through 2029, inclusive, for operation of Senior Citizen Home Delivered Meals within Tuscola County? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage raises an estimated \$457,626 in the first year that it is levied. All revenue will be disbursed to Tuscola County and shall be exclusively used for Senior Citizen Home Delivered Meals within Tuscola County.

### **TUSCOLA COUNTY SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAM RENEWAL**

Shall Tuscola County renew the current Senior Citizen Programs millage levy of 0.3200 mills (\$.32 per \$1,000 of taxable value) upon the taxable value of property in Tuscola County for a period of 8 years, 2025 through 2032, inclusive, for operation of Senior Citizen programs within Tuscola County? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage raises an estimated \$732,202 in the first year that it is levied. All revenue will be disbursed to Tuscola County and shall be exclusively used for Senior Citizen activities within Tuscola County.

### **TUSCOLA COUNTY SHERIFF ROAD PATROL RENEWAL**

Shall Tuscola County renew the current Sheriff Road Patrol millage levy of 1.3300 mills (\$1.33 per \$1,000 of taxable value) upon the taxable value of property in Tuscola County, for a period of 8 years, 2025 through 2032, inclusive, for operation of the Tuscola County Sheriff's Road Patrol within Tuscola County? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage raises an estimated \$3,043,213 in the first year that it is levied. All revenue will be disbursed to Tuscola County and shall be exclusively used for Sheriff's Road Patrol activities within Tuscola County.

### **ALMER CHARTER TOWNSHIP ROAD MILLAGE**

Shall Almer Charter Township, County of Tuscola, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed 1.0 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), of which .9946 mill is renewal of the previously authorized millage rate that expires in 2024 and .0054 mill is new additional millage to restore the full amount of the previously authorized millage rate lost as a result of the Headlee Amendment reductions, against all taxable property within the Township for a period of four (4) years, 2025 to 2028, inclusive, for the purpose of constructing, preserving, improving, repairing, and maintaining roads, bridges, and street systems within Almer Charter Township? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the first year (2025) is approximately \$75,000.

### **ARBELA TOWNSHIP ROAD REPAIR RENEWAL**

Shall the tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes which may be imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in any one (1) year upon the property in the Township of Arbela, in the amount of one (1) mill of the taxable valuation of all property in said Township, be renewed for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2024 through 2028, inclusive, for secondary road repair and reconstruction. This proposal will raise in the first year of the levy an estimated sum of \$89,640.00 (or \$1.00 for every \$1,000.00 of taxable value), and a like amount in subsequent years.

### **ELKLAND TOWNSHIP ROAD IMPROVEMENT**

Shall Elkland Township levy up to 1.25 mills (\$1.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for six (6) years, 2024 through 2029, inclusive, on all taxable real and personal property in the Township for disbursement to Elkland Township for the purpose of local road repairs, upgrades, construction, improvement and maintenance purposes, which levy will raise in the first year an estimated sum of \$149,600.

### **KOYLTON TOWNSHIP IMPROVEMENT & MAINTENANCE ROAD RENEWAL**

Shall the previously voted increase in the 15 mill tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Koylton Township be renewed at 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1000.00 of taxable value) for the period of 4 years, 2025 through 2028 inclusive, for the sole and exclusive purpose of the improvement and maintenance of roads within Koylton Township and shall the Township levy such renewal millage for the said purpose, thereby, raising in the first year an estimated \$90,000.00?

**MILLINGTON TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONAL RENEWAL**

For the purpose of continuing funding for fire department operations in Millington Township, including, but not limited to, first responder services, fire equipment purchase, and housing, shall the previous voted increases in the tax limitation imposed under article IX, section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Millington Township, as constitutionally reduced, be renewed at the total combined reduced rate of up to 0.7417 mills (\$0.7417 per \$1,000 in taxable value), and levied for a period of six (6) years, 2025-2030, inclusive? If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$108,573.00 in the first calendar year of the levy, based on state taxable valuation. If approved a portion of the millage will be disbursed to the Village of Millington Downtown Development Authority.

**NOVESTA TOWNSHIP ROAD RENEWAL**

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within the Township of Novesta be renewed at 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2025 through 2028 inclusive, the funds to be used to provide ditching, grading, graveling, and paving of roads within the Township of Novesta; and shall the Township levy such millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$71,627.78?

**WATERTOWN TOWNSHIP ROAD**
