Persons seeking nomination in the May 19, 2020 Democratic or Republican Primary should file a Declaration of Candidacy and Affidavit and pay the qualifying fee to the County Executive Committee at the location designated by the Party.

Candidates seeking election in the May 19, 2020 Non-Partisan election should file a Notice of Candidacy and pay the qualifying fee to the Meriwether County Board of Elections located at 137 S. Court Square Greenville, GA beginning at 9:00am Monday, March 2, 2020 until 12:00 noon on Friday, March 6, 2020. Qualifying hours are Monday 9:00-5:00, Tuesday – Thursday 8:30-5:00 and Friday, 8:30-12:00 Noon.

Independent and Political Body Candidates for the November 3, 2020 General Election may qualify beginning Monday, March 2, 2020 at 9:00 am until 12:00 noon on Friday, March 6, 2020 by filing a notice of candidacy and paying the qualifying fee at The Meriwether County Board of Elections office located at 137 S. Court Square, Greenville, GA. In addition to the notice of candidacy a nomination Petition will be due no earlier than June 22, 2020 and no later than July 14, 2020 at 12:00 Noon.
