The Workshop will cover the following topics:

- AWIA Small Systems Resilience — *This topic provides a refresh of the AWIA Deadlines and Requirements; introduce AWWA/RCAP Risk & Resiliency Resources for RRAs and ERPs; and equip small systems to be resilient to all hazards*
- Regulatory Overview — *Presented by the Office of Drinking Water*
- Large Building Water Quality Issues - *Recognize water quality challenges of premise plumbing systems in large buildings; discuss the difference between water supplier and building owner responsibilities; and identify actions to take from the water supply side to help mitigate or prevent water quality issues*
- PFAS – Contaminant of Concern — *Attendees will achieve greater knowledge of PFAS/PFOA and associated health concerns; understand current regulations; identify proper sampling procedures; understand how to address the problem, and identify resources for assistance*
- Controlling Lead in Drinking Water - *Topics covered in the workshop include the regulations; corrosion basics; conducting an inventory; monitoring requirements; treatment requirements; public notification requirements; and lead service line replacement.*
