Having fun is one of RecoveryWerks! core values. The therapeutic value of fun for teens is teaching them that they can have fun without using mind-altering substances. Just as importantly, having fun gives the teen a good reason to be a part of our recovery group. Our fun is not adult fun, it is teen fun. It is an adventurous fun that has a teen climbing a rock wall one day on a retreat, pranking a counselor with a lizard, going heavy-metal on guitars, playing in a ping pong tournament, or going to the caverns for their first spelunking adventure. In addition to being fun, these outings give our teens "war stories" to counter the stories their friends have about using substances.

Fun for family members is just as important because family members slowly forget how to have fun. A couple recounted going on a drive to an amusement park after being in recovery for six months. The husband told a joke, and they laughed until they were in tears. They both looked at each other and said, "Wow! It has been a long time since we really laughed." For them, it was almost a year and a half since they had laughed like that. Fun also fosters the relationships family members need in recovery.
