Meeting of the DeKalb County Commission
Commissioner's Room 9:00 A.M.

Present was Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison, East District Commissioner Garry McFee, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison and those in attendance said a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to approve the agenda for April 24, 2017.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the minutes with East District Commissioner, Garry McFee making the second. Motion carried.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee attended the Colfax Township Zoning meeting. They requested help with a tube needing replaced. The Commission will talk to Road & Bridge.

The tube on Railroad St. was discussed. Bill Gray placed flags and he will get in touch with the City about getting it replaced.

Representatives from PACA, (Positive Action Community Association) Beulah McManus and Barbara Owen met with the Commission to discuss a directory their group is working on. The directory will have phone numbers of businesses in the area that will benefit patrons. PACA is asking for funds for the County to help with the costs of the directory. The Commission approved a full page at the cost of \$100.00.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray met with the Commission. Discussion was had to install a tube on Ridgeline Road by the County at the Township's expense. Bill will do the locate with dig rite. He also advised that a tube was cleaned out on NE Wolf Creek Rd., and per the bridge inspection a bridge on Gospel Rd. needs new deck boards or tore out as bridge goes to nowhere. The Commission asked Bill if they had any needs or wants for their department.

Michael Marriott, Scott Stephens and Jeff Dennis of MODOT met with the Commission to discuss bridge report. It was noted that bridge inspections are done every 2 years and that DeKalb County has done an excellent job in keeping our bridges up and in good shape. 52% of the bridges in the County are in good condition, 43% are in fair and only 5% are in poor condition. MODOT told the Commission they do a good job in taking care of their bridges and told them to keep up the good work. County Clerk, Melissa Meek asked for a report to say where we were in the State on these statistics. Scott Stephens will check into that and report back to the Commission.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to adjourn with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. Motion carried. 3-0
