### SHERIFF'S CORNER

In order to ensure that everyone who needs to contact emergency services has the opportunity to do so, the Charlotte County Sheriff's Office participates in the national program "Secure the Call." Any cell phone that is no longer in use can be donated to the not-for-profit "Secure the Call" program. The old cell phones are refurbished; all of the existing data is removed, and they are reformatted for use only as 911 emergency call devices.

You can drop off your old cell phones at the Oak Hollow office.
