SPANISH VALLEY WATER & SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

Regular Meeting ----- March 20, 1991

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, ATTENDANCE W. Darwin Gilger, at 7:00 P.M. at the District office. Other Board members present were Dan Holyoak, Neal Dalton and Bud Cunningham.

Others present were Dorane Fullmer, Tim Keogh, Dale Pierson, Marsha Modine and Roberta Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of MINUTES February 20, 1991. Neal moved the minutes be approved as read. Dan seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Ms. Fullmer stated she would like to hook her TANGREN SEWER parents, the Doug Tangrens, up to the sewer, and asked if the CONNECTION back fees could be forgiven so that they could connect to the sewer. After a discussion, the Board decided to table the request while they collected further information.

The Board discussed the Tangren connection and Dale suggested that if the Board forgave anything, it should be the connection fee. Dan asked for a report of the people who are not hooked up and are paying the fees, and who are not hooked up and not paying the fees, etc. and suggested the Board plan on getting everyone connected to the sewer.

Tim Keogh asked about the land trade that had been KEOGH LAND discussed previously, of the tank site for a piece of TRADE property just below the tank site suitable for a lift station. Dale stated the attorney had given the opinion this was legal as long as the trade documents stated clearly that the two pieces of property were of equal value. Dale suggested Tim view the properties tomorrow, and if the Board also wants to view the properties they should.

With regard to the Neet proposal, Neal suggested NEET PROPOSAL if they buy a piece of property, pay a sewer connection they can construct a dump station. It was also suggested he deal with the city for a dump station.

With regard to the Public Radio Station, Neal PUBLIC RADIO stated he had no objection to giving them free connections. Dan stated that he felt they should pay the actual cost of making the connection. Dan pointed out that since we have to pay GCWCD for the cost of water, and the City of Moab a fee for the sewer, we should charge the monthly fees. It was suggested that we not charge the station if they can get the City to not charge us for that connection. After a discussion, Neal moved the District grant water and sewer connections to the Public Radio Station at the actual cost of materials and labor. Bud seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Dale reported the cost of the culinary water line to All American Acres had been reduced to \$417,500.00. We are now required to give notice of the application for a C.I.B. Grant. There will be a public hearing on the grant application which will be the next regular meeting, April 17, 1991.

Roberta reported the terms of George White and Dar-TRUSTEES win Gilger have expired and she has talked with George, who TERMS wants to serve another term.

Marsha reported that the ITT has now lost a disk COMPUTER drive. Since the bid for a new computer was lower than anticipated, the District has enough money budgeted for to purchase a new one, rather than repair the ITT. The new DOS is much higher than our present machines, and two identical machines will be more efficient. After a brief discussion, Dan moved to purchase the Everix computer for the District. Bud seconded. MOTION CARRIED.
