- I. By love serve (*douleuo – dool-yoo´-o*) one another. (*13*)
 - A. Douleuo means to be a slave; voluntary or involuntary.
 - B. A better rendering would be “by love become a servant of one another”.
 - C. Since all the law can be fulfill in one word; so, can all the Fruit of the Spirit be fulfilled in one word; Love.
 - D. Without walking after the leading of the Holy Spirit, which infuse us with this love, we will bite and devour one another. (*Rom. 5:5*)
 - E. If we don’t allow the Fruit of the Spirit to be manifest in our lives; we will manifest some form of the works of the flesh.
- II. Each Fruit of the Spirit is a different manifestation of love.
 - A. Joy is love’s cheerfulness.
 - a. Joy will counter sadness and depression.
 - B. Peace is love at rest.
 - a. Peace will counter disturbance, worry, and fear.
 - C. Longsuffering is love’s endurance.
 - a. Longsuffering will counter impatience.
 - D. Gentleness is love’s disposition.
 - a. Gentleness will counter harshness and meanness.
 - E. Goodness is love’s generosity.
 - a. Goodness will counter wickedness and selfishness.
 - F. Faithfulness is love’s commitment.
 - a. Faithfulness will counter infidelity.
 - G. Meekness is love’s temperament.
 - a. Meekness will counter pride and self-conceitedness.
 - H. Temperance is love’s moderation.
 - a. Temperance will counter self-indulgence.
- III. The remedy for a lack of the Fruit of the Spirit is to crucify the flesh. (*Please read and study each scripture verse attentively! Rom. 6:6-16*)
 - A. Destroy the body of sin. (*6*)
 - B. Death of the flesh will free us free from sin. (*7-10*)
 - a. How are we dead with Christ? _____

- IV. The process of producing the fruit. (Rom. 5:1-5)
 - A. Rejoice in the hope of the glory of God. (2)
 - B. Glory in tribulation (pressure, affliction, persecution, or trouble). (3)
 - a. Tribulation produces and completes patience.
 - b. Patience produces and completes experience (proof or trustworthiness by testing). (4)
 - c. Experience produces hope; to anticipate with confidence. (4)
 - d. Hope will not leave us ashamed. (5)

- VI. It's time to stop acting childish. (1 Cor. 3:1-3; 13:11)
