

# God's Process at Work

*"And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ" (Philippians 1:6).*

Life is a series of process. You will always have things you are processing. The good news is, God's Word never fails, God's Word never goes void and God's Word NEVER lacks God's power. Whatever your processing, He is able to help you. His purpose is for you is to depend on Him and on His power now. *"Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him, and he will act. He will bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday"* (Psalm 37:3-6).
