**About UnityWorks:** UnityWorks is a 501(c)3 nonprofit educational organization whose mission is to promote cross-racial and cross-cultural understanding, equity and inclusion, with a focus on K-12 schools. We are committed to a belief in the oneness of humanity, the value of diversity, and the need for unity. We work primarily with teachers, school administrators and community leaders, offering professional development, educational resources and ongoing support.

**The Need:** With a largely white, middle class, monolingual teaching force, and an increasingly diverse student population, there is a critical need to provide educators with training, tools, strategies and support in order to effectively address the equity and diversity issues in our classrooms and schools. In light of the current national environment, with the continued polarization of our society and an increased awareness of the need for racial justice, programs like UnityWorks are not only timely, but urgent and necessary.

**Funding:** For the past six years, UnityWorks has been preparing educators in Central Washington State to systematically address the diversity issues in their classrooms and schools. We are now ready to expand to additional districts and are seeking individual donors and corporate sponsors who share our commitment to reducing prejudice and building local capacity for positive multicultural change. Since school budgets are limited, the fees we are able to charge only cover a portion of our actual costs, so we rely on grants and donations, and are grateful for the services of a dedicated all-volunteer Board.
