

## Cherry Pickin' with the Double Wide 4 Patch Dresden

### Supplies needed:

- Double Wide 4 Patch Dresden Template
- Rotary Cutter: 45mm recommended
- Rotating cutting mat for trimming units (very helpful!!) 8x8" is a good size
- Rotary cutting mat for cutting strips
- Rotary cutting ruler for cutting strips and squares
- Sewing machine & cord!
- ¼" foot, regular piecing foot, & zig zag foot
- Piecing thread that matches fabrics ( I prefer Aurafil 50wt.)
- Pressing tools: Iron, mat, pressing spray
- Purple Thang for poking out the points!
- Scissors
- Piecing pins
- Q Tools Cutting Edge or Sandpaper dots to hold template in place

### Fabrics:

#### For the 3-block quilt:

- (120) 3" squares
- (3) 14.5" background squares
- OPTIONAL: Borders: (3) 3"x 40" strips AND (4) 3" squares for cornerstones
- 1 ½ yard for backing
- 20 x 50" Batting
- (4) 2 ½ x 40" strips for binding

#### For a 9-Block Quilt: You will NOT finish the quilt but get a really great start on the blocks!

- (360) 3" squares...Keep it scrappy OR organized like my mod dresdens! I used 1 dark, 1 medium, & 2 lights for EACH unit... 10 UNITS = 1 Dresden. SO ... On my quilt there are 2 Dresdens in Red, Green, Blue, Yellow, Orange, and Purple.
- (9) 14.5" background squares
