## (Published in The Garnett Review August 5,1926) ORDINANCE NO. 966.

An Ordinance vacating the alley between lots one, (1), and two, (2), and nineteen, (19), in Block twelve, (12), in Chapman's Addition to the City of Garnett also vacating that part of Oak Street in said Addition south of the north line of said alley.

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Garnett:
Section 1, That the alley between lots one, (1), and two, (2), and nineteen, (19), in Block twelve, (12), in Chapman's Addition to the City of Garnett, also that part of Oak Street in said Addition south of the north line of said alley be and the same is hereby vacated, Provided That part of said alley and the street hereby vacated shall be subject to taxation as other real property.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force ten days after its final passage and its publication in The Garnett Review.
