#5/6/7 Always "a Maine Corporation" and attachment #2 must be changed Is this a divided lot or a whole lot? Is this Map 22 Lot 7 or something else?

Primitive recreation does not include ATVs or dirt bikes. The applicant will add ATV trails and dirt bike trails to the list #11. NW will not charge anything for ATVs. Once again we recommended they hire a Maine lawyer.

Page 8 1 1a is how many acres? 1-16 questions were asked about the traffic study and the intersection of Senator Black Road and 113. Ask MDOT about the safety of the intersection with the projected traffic.

We continued through the application making suggestions here and there. We finished with tab 1

We talked with Wes about the importance of making reports on his activities easily available to the Planning Board and the public. He said he would come up with a way to do that.
