If you drop your envelopes at the office door, please ring the doorbell to notify the office that there is a drop off and it can be picked up immediately. **Please refrain from depositing at the door outside of office hours.**

We ask that you dropp off your recycling in this bin on Mondays if possible. This will give Gail time to bring the bags to the depot and get a report for the bulletin. Please be careful as to what you put in the recycling bags. The containers must be cleaned and caps removed.
