***** MASK POLICY *****

Masks will be required for all competitors and observers. Competitors may remove their mask when on the firing line, but must put them back on as soon as they leave the firing line.

ELIGIBILITY: This competition is open to all school age competitors until August 31 of the year in which they graduate from high school or the equivalent. Teams must be made up of four individuals from the same club.

RESIDENCE: Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place Junior Olympic medals. Shooters may not compete in more than one state JOSC.

ELIGIBILITY FOR NATIONAL COMPETITION: There will be two classes of air rifle competition in this match: Sporter Air Rifle and Precision Air Rifle. Those teams in each division may participate in the 2021 National Junior Olympic Three-Position Air Rifle Championship if they achieve an automatic qualifying score.

Automatic Sporter Individual	540
Automatic Sporter Team	2100
Automatic Precision Individual	585
Automatic Precision Team	2300

RULES: National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules 2020 - 2022 Edition will apply. The shooters composing the team must be named before the first athlete shoots for that team.

COURSE OF FIRE: Sporter & Precision Air rifle – the course of fire will be 3x20 (20 prone, 20 standing, and 20 kneeling).

TIME LIMIT: Preparation time starts 10 minutes before the scheduled match time. Time limits for each position as stated in the rulebook.

SIGHTS: Sporter rifle sights: Only sights manufactured for and sold with Sporter air rifle are permitted. Please see rule 4.2.8 for further specifics.

Precision rifle sights: Any sight not containing a lens or system of lenses is permitted. Any corrective lenses must be worn by the competitor. Light filters may be fitted to the front or rear sight. Telescopes attached to the rifle are not permitted.

DISTANCE: 10 Meters

TARGETS: Sius Electronic Targets will be used for Integer scoring

COACHING: Verbal coaching is permitted for sporter competitors during the preparation period only. No verbal coaching is permitted for precision competitors after preparation / sighters starts. Non-verbal coaching is permitted during the match for both sporter and precision.

SCORING CHALLENGES: A scoring challenge of \$1.00 per shot will be charged. A 20 minute challenge period will occur after the final posting of scores for each relay.

TIES: All ties will be broken in accordance with the National Three-Position Air Rifle Council rules.

AWARDS: A gold medallion will be given to the top resident, silver medallion for the 2nd place resident, and a bronze medallion for the 3rd place resident. These will be given to winners in each division: Sporter and Precision. First place medals will be given to the first place team in each division.
