## **Scholarship Information Sheet**

The purpose of the Wake Forest Purple Heart Foundation is to provide financial aid to a Purple Heart Recipient, the deserving descendant of a Purple Heart Recipient, or a Wake Forest Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) student.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Applicant must be a Purple Heart Recipient, the descendant of a Purple Heart Recipient, OR a member of the Wake Forest High School JROTC.
- "Descendant of a Purple Heart Recipient" is defined as a son, stepson, daughter, stepdaughter, grandchild, adopted child, or foster child of a Purple Heart Recipient.
- If Applicant is not a Purple Heart Recipient, he/she must not have reached his/her twentyfifth birthday prior to August 15<sup>th</sup> of the year in which the scholarship is awarded. There is no age restriction if the Applicant is a Purple Heart Recipient.
- Applicant must be enrolled in or have been accepted to an undergraduate program at a twoyear or four-year college or university.
- Applicant must attend on-campus classes at the college or university on a full-time basis.

### SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

- The level of funding per scholarship and/or the number of scholarships awarded may vary as deemed necessary by the Wake Forest Purple Heart Foundation Board of Directors.
- The minimum award granted to a scholarship recipient will be \$500.
- The scholarship is not recurring. Applicants are eligible to receive only ONE (1) scholarship from the program.
- No restriction will be placed on the degree or course of study in which the student is enrolled.
- Scholarship funds may be used to pay tuition, fees, on-campus lodging, books, or any other expenses managed or directed through the cashier's office of the recipient's college or university.
- Scholarships may be rescinded and funds reclaimed by the Wake Forest Purple Heart Foundation if the scholarship recipient, for any reason whatsoever, fails to complete the fall semester of the academic year for which the scholarship was granted.

### SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM TIMELINE

- Applications will be accepted between March 1<sup>st</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year for the upcoming school year.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified of their selection as early as the May or June prior to enrolling in the Fall Semester. Recipient will be publicly recognized at the annual Wake Forest Purple Heart Banquet, which is held the first Saturday in each August.
- Funds will be deposited directly with the recipient's college or university after the recipient has completed at least ten (10) days of classes in the fall semester of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.

- The application must be accompanied by two reference letters that address your character, scholastic aptitude, and involvement in school and community activities. The letters should be sealed in separate envelopes. Each letter must include contact information for the reference.
- Be sure to keep a copy of the completed application packet.
