

# **EMILY JOANNE WALSH**

**1907 - 1986**

Emily J. Walsh, age 79, of Pigeon, formerly of Pinnebog, died Thursday, Dec. 18 at Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe.

She was born Sept. 14, 1907 in Spruce, daughter of the late Alex and Mary (Mousseau) Bushey. She was united in marriage to Edward J. Walsh on Oct. 30, 1930 at St. Felix Catholic Church, near Pinnebog. He preceded her in death in June of 1970.

Mrs. Walsh was a rural school teacher at Port Crescent for a number of years. She and her husband owned and operated the General Store in Pinnebog for 25 years, until they began farming in 1945. She was a member of St. Felix Catholic Church and its Altar Society.
