

ORDINANCE NO 780.

An Ordinance levying a corporate tax on property in the City of Garnett, Kansas. Special sewer assessments and paving assessments for the City of Garnett, Kansas, for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1920.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Mayor and commissioners of the city of Garnett, Kansas.

Section 1. That a corporate ^{Tax} ~~be~~ and hereby ^{the same is} ~~be~~ levied on all the taxable property of the city of Garnett, Kansas, for the General Fund purpose of 30 cents on the One Hundred dollars valuation.

Section 2. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all the taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Street and Alley purposes 12 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 3. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Water works Fund 12 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 4. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Electric Light Fund 12 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 5. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Fire Fund 5 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 6. That a corporate tax be and ^{the same is} ~~be~~ hereby ~~be~~ levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Library fund 5 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 7. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Water Works Extension Bond Sinking fund, 8 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section. 8. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Water Works Extension Bond Interest Fund, 6 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section. 9. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Water Works ~~200~~ Extension Bond Sinking Fund, 1913, 2 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 10. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Water Works Extension Bond Interest Fund, 1913, 2 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 11. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Water works Improvement Bond Sinking Fund, 2 1/2 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 12. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the City of Garnett, Kansas, for Water Works Improvement Bond Interest Fund 4 1/2 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 13. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Electric Light Bond Sinking Fund, 2 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 14. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Electric Light Interest Fund, 4 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 15. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Main Sewer Bond Sinking Fund, 5 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 16. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Main Sewer Bond Interest Fund, 5 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 17. That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Paving Intersectional Bond Fund, 20 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 18. That a ~~special~~ special assessment is hereby made on all lots and pieces of ground in Sewer District No. 1 liable for sewer assessments for the purpose of paying one tenth of the original assessment and six per cent interest on two-tenths of the original assessments for one year.

Section 19. That a special assessment is hereby made on all lots and pieces of ground in Sewer District No. 2, liable for sewer assessments to pay one-tenth of the original assessment and six-per cent interest on two tenths of the original assessment for one year.

Section 20. That a special assessment is hereby made on all lots and pieces of ground in Sewer District No.3. liable for sewer assessment and six per cent interest on two-tenths of the original assessment for one year.

Section 21. That a special assessment is hereby made on all lots and pieces of ground in the Paving District liable for special assessment for paving to pay one tenth of the original assessment and (4 & 3/4) four and three fourths per cent interest on Eight tenths of the original assessment for one year except on Fourth Avenue between the blocks 50 and 31, 49 and 32, 48 and 38, 47 and 34, 46 and ³⁵ and on Fifth avenue between the blocks 46 and 55, and on Oak street between ^{blocks} 46 and 47 , on which a special assessment is hereby made to pay one tenth of the original assessment and (4 & 3/4) four and three fourths per cent interest on seven-~~te~~ tenths of the original assessment.

~~Section. 22. That a special assessment is hereby made on all lots and pieces of ground liable for paving assessment to pay one-tenth of the original assessment and (4 & 3/4) four and three fourths per cent interest on all the original assessment on Oak Street between blocks 34 and 25, 26 and 27~~

Section 2~~2~~ That a corporate tax be and the same is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Water and Light Improvement Bonds Sinking fund, 1918, 5 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 2³. That a corporate tax be and ^{the same} is hereby levied on all taxable property in the city of Garnett, Kansas, for Water and Light Improvement Bond Interest fund, 1918, 16 cents on each one hundred dollars valuation.

Section 2⁴. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after ten days after its passage by the board of commissioners and approval by the Mayor and publication in the official paper.
