Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Garry McFee and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and East District Commissioner, Garry McFee welcomed those in attendance with Kyle Carroll leading the group in prayer followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the November 4, 2019 meeting were read with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the motion to approve. East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the second. Motion carried.

The Commission welcomes all those who come in to attend the opening of their meetings. Anyone in the County is invited to their weekly meetings.

Peggy Harwood met with the Commission to discuss the Senior Services Fund budget. County Clerk, Melissa Meek advised they would amend the budget next Monday.

The Commission met with DNR on Wednesday the 6th of November to discuss the new courthouse roof. Attending this meeting was Representative J Eggleston, Senator Dan Hegeman, Director and Deputy State Historic Preservation Officer, Toni Prawl, Ph.D., Director of Policy and Legislative Affairs, Rich Germinder, Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Garry McFee and County Clerk, Melissa Meek. The group toured the building to review the roof and assess all of the damage to the interior. Also discussed was the historical status of the building.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek discussed an incorrect address for an easement letter for the BRO project that Howe & Associates was trying to send to a patron. The correct address was found and forwarded on to Shannon Howe.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek advised the Commission on fund balances as well as the sales and use tax reports.

Emergency Management received a good report from SEMA.

ISA-Certified Arborist, Martha E. Clark at the request of Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll did a tree assessment of all trees on the courthouse lawn. The request was made due to the health of some of the trees on the lawn. At this time nothing is going to be done but will possibly make a decision on them in the spring.

Prosecuting Attorney, Erik Tate and Victim Advocate Joni Ignatenko, met with the Commission to advise that the Victim's Advocate Grant had been approved and had an increase in funds. The Commission thanked Joni and Erik for their hard work and dedication on this grant. It was noted that some counties were not eligible to get this grant for 2020 or their funds were decreased.
