WHO IS THIS FOR?

Nature Intervention is a therapy-style program for 5-12 year old children (and caregiver) with a: learning disability, speech-language delay, sensory impairment, and/or on the autism spectrum. The program works to increase children's language, interactions, and comfort in the outdoors. For caregivers, this program gives ideas for engagement in new activities while giving strategies to work on child's skills.
