

ORDINANCE NO 777.

An ordinance relating to certain registration fees concerning dogs and bitches in the city of Garnett, Kansas.

Section 1. The owner or harborer of any dog or dogs shall without delay after the publication hereof, or as soon as any dog shall come ~~in~~ into his or her possession, and annually thereafter before the first day of May in each year, give his or her name and description of his or her dog to the city clerk, who shall register such name in a suitable book kept for that purpose. The city clerk shall deliver to said owner or harborer a check stamped "T P", with number and year of registry, and said owner or harborer shall affix to the collar of his or her dog such check.

The city clerk shall charge a fee of one (1) dollar for each dog, and five (5) dollars for each bitch registered by him, which sum shall be paid by said clerk into the city treasury on the first day of the next month thereafter.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after ten days from its passage, approval and publication in the Garnett Review.
