

Peter Auricchio is a versatile trumpet player from Stony Brook, New York. Mr. Auricchio plays with a commanding yet refined sound and is comfortable in a variety of musical styles from 16th Century Baroque to 21st Century Commercial. Since the turn of the Millennium, he has performed across the United States and Europe at such venues as Carnegie Hall, Boston Symphony Hall, Seiji Ozawa Hall, Alice Tully Hall, The Royal Northern College of Music in Manchester England, Castello Orsini in Soriano Italy, Boettcher Hall, St. Bart's Cathedral, The Saratoga Performing Arts Center, Nassau Coliseum and The Beacon Theatre ...to name only a few. Mr. Auricchio has been a member of the International Trumpet Guild since 1997.

Mr. Auricchio received his Bachelors of Music in Trumpet Performance from the Boston University College of Fine Arts in 2003. While at B.U. Peter studied with Terry Everson, a world renowned recital soloist and freelancer in the Boston area. In 2002 Peter placed runner-up in the International Trumpet Guild's Moch Orchestra Competition which was held at the ITG Conference in Manchester, England. Upon the completion of his Bachelors Degree, Peter spent 9 months traveling across the United States with the 2nd National Tour of Cole Porter's *Kiss Me Kate!*. In 2007, Peter received his Masters Degree in Trumpet Performance with a Jazz Emphasis from the Lamont School of Music at The University of Denver. While at the Lamont School, Peter studied with Alan Hood, know for his distinctive jazz and lead playing and as the definitive authority on the life and career of jazz great, Clifford Brown.

Since his return to New York in 2011, Mr. Auricchio has become a staple of the Long Island music scene, playing with a myriad of different ensembles from rock bands, jazz big bands and musicals to classical chamber music and symphony orchestras. In addition to all of the performing, Mr. Auricchio also has developed a teaching studio of exceptional young students in the Suffolk county area.
