

“Five Hallelujahs of Heaven”

Revelation 19:1–6

I. Hallelujah when salvation has come to God’s people.

Revelation 19:1 — “*After these things I heard something like a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, “Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God;*”

A. God’s salvation has arrived as enemy strongholds begin to fall.

B. This salvation will come with Glory.

1. **2 Thessalonians 1:6–7** — “*6 For after all it is only just for God to repay with affliction those who afflict you, 7 and to give relief to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire,*”

2. **Colossians 3:4** — “*4 When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.*”

3. **2 Thessalonians 1:10** — “*10 when He comes to be glorified in His saints on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed—for our testimony to you was believed.*”

C. This salvation will come with mighty power – Isaiah 64:1–2

II. Hallelujah is for when perfect justice is handed out to the wicked.

v2 “*because His judgments are true and righteous; for He has judged the great harlot who was corrupting the earth with her immorality, and He has avenged the blood of His bond-servants on her.*”

A. After much patience, perfect justice must be dispensed to the guilty.

1. God first gives plenty of opportunity to get right with Him - **Romans 2:4**

B. God must be praised for giving out justice. Hallelujah!!

1. **Lesson:** Take advantage now for there is abundant mercy to him who washes his sins the blood of the Lamb.

III. There must be Hallelujah when rebellion against God has ended.

v3 “*And a second time they said, “Hallelujah! Her smoke rises up forever and ever.”4 And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sits on the throne saying, “Amen. Hallelujah!”*”

A. God’s judgement is final and permanent.

1. This forever smoke means that the destruction is permanent.

B. God’s judgement on the unrepentant is equally eternal.

1. The angel warned the people that torment would never end - **Revelation 14:11**

C. Lesson: May God see faithfulness in the choices of our life.

IV. Hallelujah when God has begun to reign over men.

5 “*And a voice came from the throne, saying, “Give praise to our God, all you His bond-servants, you who fear Him, the small and the great.”6 Then I heard something like the voice of a great multitude and like the sound of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, saying, “Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns.”*”

A. The reign of the evil and the selfish will be replaced by the perfect, the righteous and the holy.

1. Daniel extols the Kingdom of the Messiah - **Daniel 7:14**

2. Everyone who follow Christ will reign with him in His coming kingdom - **Revelation 20:6**
