# Seminar teaches men why it is important to have prostate screening

One in six men will have prostate cancer. The Alabama Cooperative Extension System is joining forces with the Alabama Comprehensive Cancer Control Coalition's Prostate Services and the Lawrence County Health Department to "Create a Buzz about Blue".

The "Blue" being buzzing about is prostate cancer awareness, which is symbolized by a blue ribbon. To raise awareness about prostate cancer prevention, a Blue Seminar will be held here in Moulton.

"We want to educate church and community leaders so they can educate the men they interact with on a daily basis about prostate cancer," said Tamekie Washington, state manager of the Prostate Cancer Program, which is funded by the Centers for Disease Control for the Alabama Department of Public Health.

A Prostate Cancer Awareness BLUE Seminar will be held on Thursday, May 17, from 5:00-8:00 p.m. at First United Methodist Church on Market Street, Moulton. A free meal is being sponsored by the Prostate Cancer Program.

Lawrence County's Regional Extension Agents Melanie Allen and Elaine Softley will make presentations about cancer statistics and the link between

nutrition and cancer prevention.

Dr. Thomas Moody, a board certified urologist with Urology Centers of Alabama based in Birmingham, will be the medical speaker. Dr. Moody will speak on general prostate health, cancer screenings, treatment options and answer questions. He has been practicing in Birmingham since 1978. Dr. Moody's mission is to assure that every man in Alabama is provided an avenue to be screened for prostate cancer, and he goes the extra mile to do so. Dr. Moody views what he does as his "mission work" and freely uses his abilities and knowledge to help others.

Dr. Moody is described by his peers as an amazing man and that his commitment and dedication to fight prostate cancer in Alabama is unsurpassed. Department on Saturday, May 19, from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. for FREE Prostate Cancer Screenings. The free screenings include the PSA (prostate specific antigen). These screenings will find 90 percent of prostate cancer. Men age 40 and older need to have these test done each year. No appointment is needed.

The goal of the BLUE Seminar on May 17, is to educate men 18 years old and older and the women in their lives about prostate health and the importance of early detection and the effectiveness of treatments.

The seminar is for anyone who is interested in learning more about prostate health. While supplies last, participants at the seminar will receive free prostate health promotional materials such as a ball cap and desktop clock.
