1. **Superintendent Reza Namin:** Introduced himself to the selectman and spoke about the upcoming school budget and the impact it would have on the property taxes.
2. **Roll Call:** Selectwoman Robin Cyr, Selectman Doug Dixon and Selectwoman Melissa Patterson.
3. **Secretary's Report:** Selectwoman Cyr motioned to accept, Selectman Dixon seconded.
4. **Assessing and Abatements:** None

6. **New Business:** River Hearing Ordinance: Motioned to accept Selectwoman Patterson, seconded by Selectwoman Cyr. All in favor.

11. **Sewer Fee Increase:** Robin Patterson asked about the increase. The increase was implemented in September and was added to the January bill.
12. **Pump Station Talk:** Snowdon Engineering will give an update on the Center Line Survey, Core drilling and the companies that are interested.

13. **Walking Trail, Crummet Street Update:** The town will be looking to add 4 new parking spaces and to pave the lot.
14. **Bog Road Bridge:** The Economic Development Committee will look at details at the next meeting. Also it is a TIFF district.
15. **LED Lighting:** Selectman Dixon stated he will bring details to the next selectman's meeting and that the saving should be huge.
