



## Teacher Application 2025 Yuuyaraq Cultural Immersion Camps

Yuuyaraq is a term meaning “the way of being” encompassing social/familial interactions, traditional knowledge pertaining to subsistence and environmental activities, philosophy for a good life, self-awareness, language, and our relationship to our surroundings. And, so much more.

The Yuuyaraq Cultural Immersion Camps provide an opportunity for 1st and 2nd year teachers in the Calista Region to learn the Yuuyaraq curriculum alongside 7th and 8th grade students. Yuuyaraq teaches Yup’ik/Cup’ik culture and history, traditions, and values emphasizing the importance of protecting and respecting the environment in the Calista Region. The camps provide a rich opportunity for new teachers to learn directly from Elders, experience hands-on cultural orientation, increase cultural knowledge and awareness, and improve pedagogical knowledge while working with Yup’ik students and families.

Although this experience is a brief immersion into Yup’ik/Cup’ik culture we are hopeful participants will gain a new perspective of the Yup’ik culture and Yugtun (Yup’ik) language and leave with a new passion for learning, while living and teaching in one of our communities.

### Yuuyaraq Cultural Immersion Camp Schedule:

Three (9) day camps will take place to introduce Yuuyaraq. The camps include a **one-day** Teacher Orientation in Anchorage, Alaska, followed by travel to our remote campsite location for the duration of camp.

One (5) day Fall Camp will be held in September 2025, at Camp Gorsuch in Mirror Lake, located outside of Anchorage. The dates of this event will be determined later.
