**2019 TRIAGE/TREATMENT INSTRUCTOR #4** 

- 1. LEAD TRIAGE PERSON THROUGH EACH PATIENT
- 2. INSTRUCTOR THEN ASSISTS AT TREATMENT AREA TO MAKE SURE TRANSPORT TO TREATMENT AREA IS BEING DONE CORRECTLY.
- 3. HAS EQUIPMENT BEEN CALLED FOR? (BACKBOARDS)
- 4. Work with Medical Director to have EXTRICATION Team REASSIGNED.

3. Keep this moving...if you have to help a little that is OK.

4. <u>ALL TREATMENT AREA PATIENTS</u> WILL GET TRIAGE TAGS FILLED OUT.

7. TREATMENT AREA WILL INFORM MEDICAL OF INJURIES <u>OR</u> Go "DIRECT" with Base/PHQ to report injuries.

8. Try to have incident last no longer than 35 minutes.

9. You may need to prompt some of the slow patrollers as to make radio calls.

## **REMEMBER THE STEPS OF TRIAGE**

**CLEAR WALKING WOUNDED TO SPECIFIC AREA** 

<u>30-2-CAN DO</u> FIRST: RESPIRATIONS PRESENT?? – GO TO RESPIRATION CHECK RESPIRATIONS PRESENT - NO – OPEN AIRWAY/HEAD TILT IF RESPIRATIONS RETURN ------RED STILL NO RESPIRATIONS----BLACK

**RESPIRATION CHECK (30):** OVER 30 OR UNDER 8 – **RED** BETWEEN 8 & 30 – MOVE TO PULSE CHECK

<u>PULSE CHECK – ONLY RADIAL PULSE</u> RADIAL PULSE FOUND – MOVE TO MENTAL CHECK NO RADIAL PULSE – **RED** 

<u>MENTAL CHECK – (CAN DO)</u> CAN PATIENT PERFORM SIMPLE TASK YES – <mark>YELLOW</mark> NO – RED

**TRANSPORT ALL RED'S FIRST TO TREATMENT AREA.**
