Becoming a Member of God's Family ... An Overcomer for Christ By M.D.

So, I was sitting here this morning finishing up with my regular studies when the Lord brought you to my mind. So, I began to pray and meditate on what God would have me write for the newsletter. That's when the Lord said to me, "Write something for the man that doesn't know Me and picks up the newsletter for the first time." That's what I did and here it is.

In the Old Testament, God promised to send a Messiah, or Savior, to His people. The Messiah would save God's people from their sins, from the wrong things everyone has done. The people in the Old Testament times knew about the promise of a Savior and looked for Him.

In the New Testament, God's promise came true! The Savior was born in Bethlehem, and exactly where God had promised. Listen, "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth are from of old, From everlasting." (Micah 5:2) Jesus Christ was born, grew up and died for our sins.

God's Word always comes true. You can trust God's faithfulness, for He made it possible for you to become a member of His family - an Overcomer. Here are five easy steps to read through and follow.

Step one: God loves you

The Bible says in **1** John **4:8** that "God is love." He loves you very much. He loves you because He made you and He is concerned about you and your life today.

Step two: You have sinned

The Bible clearly says that you and ALL other people have sinned. In Romans 3:23 we read, "... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God ..."

We have all done wrong, and our sins keep us from being friends with God. As you read the Old Testament sin always leads to trouble. Because you are a sinner, your sin will cause much trouble in your life. *Romans 6:23* tells us how bad this trouble will ultimately be, "*The wages of sin is death.*" God doesn't kill you for your sins but eventually you will destroy yourself by continually sinning.

God does not want you to ruin your life with sin. It makes Him sad when you sin and spoil your happiness, and the happiness of other people in your life. Because of sin, you cannot enjoy God's loving presence in your life, AND you cannot live with God in heaven. Not one of us by even our best efforts is able to remove sin from our lives or earn God's forgiveness.

In the beginning of the Bible is the story of Adam and Eve, the first two people God created. (See **Genesis 1:26-31**) Adam and Eve lived happily with God until they disobeyed Him. (See **Genesis Chapter 3**) That was the first sin. One of the results of that sin was that Adam and Eve were separated from God, thereby robbing them of lives greatest joy and ultimately bringing the penalty of death on themselves. (Also **Genesis Chapter 3**) All of us sin and someday each of us will die too.

However, the Bible is clear that there is another life after we die. The Bible is also clear that sin will continue to separate people from God's love forever. Because everybody has sinned, how does anybody get to go to heaven?

Step three: God paid the price

The Bible continues, in *Romans 6:23-24* and says, "For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. Yet God, in His grace, freely makes us right in His sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when He freed us from the penalty for our sins." The result of sin is death. However, because God loves you so much, He offers eternal life as His free gift. You cannot work hard enough to earn eternal life. All you can do is accept it as a gift. God gave His one and only Son to die for you on the Cross. (See John 3:16)

The Bible tells us in 1 Corinthians 15:3, "Christ died for our sins, just as the Scriptures said." Because Jesus was the perfect Man (without sin) He accepted the results of sin and death in your place. 1 John 4:14 says, "... the Father sent His Son to be the Savior of the world."

Step four: God will forgive you

If you will admit to God that you have sinned and believe in your heart (See **Romans 10:9-10**) that God gave His only Son to die in your place, God will forgive you and make you clean from all sin. In fact the Bible says, in **1** John 1:9, "But if we confess our sins to Him, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness."

Tell God that you know you have been a sinner. Tell God that you believe Jesus Christ is the only way to have your sins

forgiven. Tell God that you want to learn to love and follow Christ in every area of your life. Then when you believe it, tell God how great and wonderful He is! It is easy to talk to God. Jesus taught us to talk to Him as we would a loving Father. He is always ready to listen. What you are going to tell Him He has been waiting to hear from you.

If you believe and have told God you believe, you are now a child of God! Again, Romans 10:9-10 promises, "If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved." From that moment, God has forgiven ALL of your sins ... past, present and future sins. But, just because He has forgiven even your present and future sins this does not mean that you make a mockery of His grace and use it as 'a license to sin'.

You are NOW a Christian. That makes you a member of God's family and an Overwater for Ofiritet. God has made everything right between you and Him. Romans 3:22 tells us, "We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. And this is true for everyone who believes, no matter who we are." 2 Corinthians 5:21 says, "For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ." He has forgiven you and looks on you as if you had never sinned!

Step five: NOW, you can live as God's child, an Overcomer!

The Bible tells us in John 1:12, "But to all who believed Him and accepted Him, He gave the right to become children of God." As a child of God, you receive God's gift of everlasting life. You do not have to wait to get to heaven to experience this great life, it begins the very second you confess Jesus as your Lord and Savior. God is with you now and forever. Now that you are a member of God's family and an Overcomer for Christ, God desires that you live as His child.

You CAN talk to God

You can also talk with God when you sin. Repentance means to turn away from the wrong you know you've done and then confess it to Him and He is faithful to forgive you. (Again, see **1** John 1:9) God will not only forgive you but He will also help you to do what He asks of you in His Word.

You can (MUST) read God's Word

God has given us His Word, the Bible, so that everyone can read about Him and His great love for us. You can only find out more about God by reading about Him in your Bible. As you read God's Word, you will stay close to Him. And the more you read the more you'll get to know Him better and better. His Holy Spirit in you will always help you to do what is right, when you listen and obey. *Psalm 119:11* states, *"I have hidden Your Word in my heart, that I might not sin against You."*

You CAN obey God

First of all, your heavenly Father wants you to obey Him so in His Word He tells you how you should live. Jesus summed up God's law with just these two commandments in *Matthew 22:37-39*, "You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind." This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: "Love your neighbor as yourself." God wants you to be an expression of His love in and to the world.

You CAN tell others about Jesus

Jesus speaking here in **Acts 1:8**, says this, "But you will readive power when the Nelly Splitt econes upon you. And you will be My witnesses, telling people about Me everywhere-in Jerusalem, throughout Judee, in Semarte, and to the ends of the earth," Yes this was Jesus speaking to His disciples before He returned back to His Father in heaven. Even though Jesus was speaking to His disciples, He has included you as His new disciple and so, these same words apply to you/us too. It's really easy. You can be a witness for Jesus by telling others about Him and how His love has helped you. You can ask God to give you opportunities each day to tell about Him, and to show His love! Welcome to the Family!

I've had more opportunities lately to share about Christ than ever. I've let people know about my peace. I'm hoping this peace can spread even faster through my people here than any virus could. I tell them, "Yeah, I'm ready to leave here and go home, but I'm also prepared to go home, home with a capital 'H', heaven. Leading worship these last five years has grown me a lot. Thanks to prison, I was able to find the time to return to school and I got my seminary degree ... B.M.

I felt compelled to write you a little letter and send in an article for consideration for the newsletter. I hope this gets to you in the midst of all God's blessings. I often think of you and I ask the Lord to not only richly bless you, but to keep us connected in our fellowship and allow our friendships to grow over these years.

God gave us all the capacity to discern right from wrong. For each person this inner compass known as a conscience is programmed with a distinct belief set and therefore functions differently from everyone else's. From the moment we begin processing instructions and warnings our conscience is developing a code of conduct by which we live.

Whether the authority figures in your life offered sound life principles and fair consequences, or provided little guidance of real value, your conscience collected the data. As children grow into adulthood, they pay attention to the words and actions of others. Both positive and negative results are added to the data. People who disappoint us teach just as much as those who impress.

The programming continues throughout life, so every situation we encounter has the capacity to affect our decisions and actions. The conscience is a flexible tool; it can absorb new data and adjust a person's values and perspective. That's good news for those who begin with poor programming but find valuable biblical guidance later on.

Yet flexibility is potentially bad news for those who expose themselves repeatedly to falsehood and vain philosophies. If they ignore wisdom and truth, they will assimilate the deceptive viewpoints of modern culture. The consequence itself isn't a wholly reliable resource, but it's a tool of the one who is completely trustworthy. The Holy Spirit works in conjunction with our inbom moral compass, giving direction when the conscience blares a warning, and interpreting God's Word when a course direction or correction is needed.

my fourth go around and I'll end up with just over thirteen years in once I walk away. Praise God, I will walk away with my head held high and let it be known that my relationship with Christ is the reason why I made it through.

I just went through a long season of loss. It first started with my freedom. But it took this loss to get the rest rolling, I guess. I lost who I thought I was in the process of spending the rest of my seasons with, I lost my ole lady (kind of expected that though). I lost my bio dad. Then I lost my brother, he was my closest friend. The deaths of my dad and my brother, while I was in here, made me learn how to grieve and accept God's plan without getting high to get through it. The ole lady moving on taught me that the only relationship I need to focus on is my relationship with Christ. I still have my mom, my step dad, sons and a couple of friends that are still pulling for me. I love them dearly but the focus or priority has to be the Lord!

The loss of who I thought I was, was a great loss because it has allowed me to let the Holy Spirit search my heart and teach me, little by little, just who God intends me to be. I have actually started to like who I am and love my new self, Praise God!

I don't know if this season is over yet, my mom and my step dad are both in not so great health. I hope and pray they are going to make it through this last term with me. But if not, I've learned well that this is okay too. I serve a God with a plan and even if I don't understand it, I know it's best for His purpose.

Through this season I have gained so much. I have been blessed and I am so very grateful. I finally get the opportunity to repay a little of my debt to society through service to the community. I made it on to a wild fire crew and look forward to that. We will see if that is what the Lord has intended for the next three years. I think it may be, I have had the desire to do this for a long time and it is finally happening.

Anyways ... thank you all for being who you are and doing what you do! I hope to maybe get a chance to meet some of you in the future and maybe get in the wind together. That's one of my hearts desires and one of the things I pray about, to be able to ride with brothers and sisters in Christ one day.

I lost my dad. It really rocked me and the pain I felt was really something I thought I was ready for, something 'I' could handle. He died in his home. My mother and my brother went to check on him and he had fallen and broken his hip and they found him upside down in a pool of blood. He passed a sad horrible way. All of that got my mind racing to 'foul play' due to the fact that a family friend was there with him most of the time. It seems that he and pops had words and now he won't come around anymore. This is so unlike him so my mom also doesn't understand it and has questions.

As you know satan is trying to hurt me more than I already am. BUT, I rebuke him and his trickery ways! I let him know that I am a son of the King of kings, I know of his trials and I refuse to fold or budge! I continue to pray even harder and stand in faith. It was great to hear him tell me that he loved me before he passed and that he was preparing to come visit me but it's still hard because I am away from my family and mourning by myself. You know it's difficult to mourn in here so I keep my feelings and memories to myself. Thanks for the shoulder and wiping these few tears I shed.

Ephesians 6:1-24

As you do battle against the mighty powers of darkness, fight in the strength of the church, whose power comes from the Holy Spirit. (6:10-17)

Psalm 70:1-5

Praise is important because it helps us remember who God is. Often our prayers are filled with requests for ourselves and others and we forget to thank God for what He has done and to worship Him for who He is. Don't take God for granted and treat Him as a vending machine. Even when David was afraid, he praised God. (70:4)

Proverbs 24:15-16

Don't mess with the godly, don't rob them for they may fall seven times, but every time they will rise again. Yet one calamity is enough to keep the wicked down. (24:15-16)

I was shocked and asked her, "How did you manage that?" That's when she told me, "We've been getting the newsletter for years." I'd forgotten that we'd put my dad and her on the mailing list years ago. She said she read the article and saw M.D. and knew it was my writing skills AND it was also apparent that they can see into my life and who I am in Christ today. Because of that article God has used it causing us to grow closer and begin to restore our own relationships.
