Doug Tjapkes formed the organization in 2001 based on a dream of his best friend, **Maurice Carter**, who had been behind bars for 29 years for a crime he did not commit. It was Maurice's goal to convert this negative into a positive and serve as an advocate for all prisoners with special needs. The two of them planned to work together upon his release from prison. While Maurice passed away soon after his release, Doug met this challenge and founded HFP.

Doug authored a book telling of his ten-year relationship with Maurice and their epic battle for justice entitled, *Sweet Freedom*.
