

DEPARTMENT 4 – SHEEP

- To qualify, all animals must be free of any evidence of infectious or contagious disease. Superintendent identification – Purebred animals must be identified by registry name and number, corresponding to the ear tag or tattoo number. Grade animals must be identified by farm-flock number, corresponding to the ear tag or tattoo number.
- Ages of animals will be reckoned from Sept. 1st – that is born before August 31st will be one year old, and after Sept. 1st will be two years old, etc.
- Any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions, must be removed from the fairgrounds.
- Pen lambs consist of two ram lambs and two ewe lambs.
- lock lambs consist of one ram, any age; two ewe, one year and under two years; two ewe under one year.
- Breeder's young flock consist of one ram lamb and two ewe lambs, all bred and owned by the exhibitor.
- A Get of Sire consists of four breeding animals, any age or sex, the Get of One Sire. Get need not be owned by exhibitor.
