1921-1992

Irene May Calvin, 70 of Bay Port, died Saturday evening, Jan. 25, in Bay Medical Center, Bay City, following a brief illness.

Mrs. Calvin was born in Garden on Oct. 11, 1921, the daughter of John Samuel and Eva (Horning) Lockhart. She was a 1939 graduate of Rapid River High School, graduating as valedictorian. She was married to Woodrow Howard and he preceded her in death in 1956. She then married Jesse Thurston Calvin on April 13, 1959, in Detroit, and he preceded her in death on Dec. 8, 1989.

Mrs. Calvin had been employed with the Chrysler Corporation in Detroit for 25 years before retiring and moving to Bay Port in 1981. She was a member of the Order of Eastern Star, Chapter 220 of Birmingham, and was a past matron. She was also a member of American Legion Auxiliary of Bay Port.

Surviving are one sister, Althea Loshaw of Port Huron, two brothers, Orville Lockhart of Kingston and Rueben Lockhart of El Cajon, CA, and several nieces and nephews.

One infant son and 3 brothers, Charles, Henry and Frederick Lockhart, all preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1 p.m. Wednesday (today) in Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home, Sebawaing. Rev. David Ballard will officiate. Cremation will follow the service, with burial in Caseville Township Cemetery, Caseville.
