1909 - 1989

Burton Edward Lee, age 80 of Elkton, passed away Saturday, May 27 at Provincial House, Cass City, after a long illness.

He was born March 9, 1909 in St. Joseph, son of the late Clayton and Nora (Geer) Lee. He was united in marriage to Marian Krohn on May 26, 1934 in Flint.
