## NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER 2019 TRESTLEBOARD

**IMPORTANT NEWS:** Our annual Stated Communication, which will consist of the election of officers for the ensuing Masonic year and closed installation of officers will take place on 02 December 2019. Please make every effort to attend this important meeting.

### FROM THE EAST

We had a very eventful October Stated. Thank you to all who were able to come out. WBro. Walter P. Benesch, PDDGHP of Springfield Lodge No. 217 and Annandale Chapter 77 presented a fantastic program on York Rite Masonry. It was well received by the Brethren. I am putting the finishing touches on a program I will give at the November Stated titled, "Veterans and the National Emblem, Saluting in Lodge: What Does the Law Say and Other Flag Etiquette?" And, of course our December Stated will consist of our Annual Stated, election of officers, and closed installation of officers. I hope that you can make it to both. Again, if you would like to come to lodge, but are unable to drive, please let myself or the Secretary know and we will arrange a ride for you. Also, as a reminder, I am keeping lodge attire comfortable through November; business casual (collared shirt and slacks, at a minimum).

I am still looking for Brethren to fulfill various roles at the Lodge. Let me know if you want to get involved in the line this coming year, and in what capacity. We have a significantly older membership. Many of the roles that have been filled by our stalwart members are potentially open to allow our newer Brothers to get involved and continue the pendulum upswing we have worked hard to achieve the past several years. YOUR lodge needs you.

Our annual fraternal visit with Rossville Lodge No. 397, Rossville, GA took place on October 11-13, 2019. I was humbled by the absolute Southern hospitality shown by the Brethren of Rossville Lodge No. 397 during my visit. This year marked the 52nd anniversary of fraternal relations between the Lodges. All of the Brethren were fantastic company and provided me with memories that will last a lifetime. I thoroughly enjoyed the exposure to Georgia ritual, both in a Communication and an Entered Apprentice Degree. I also had the opportunity to observe a full form Templar Inspection. All of the Brethren and their ladies were excellent escorts, made me feel very welcome, and they spared no expense or time to ensure I had plenty to do. This was also a special and historical trip. Lady Seaford and her daughter accompanied me in honor of our dear departed RWor. Charlie Seaford, who passed to the Celestial Lodge above earlier this year. Lady Seaford had enjoyed the Rossville trips just as much as Charlie and she thought he would have wanted her to visit this year despite his physical absence. We are already planning programs for their visit to Annandale next year; they would like to come earlier in the week and spend more time with us. Some ideas include a visit to Brother and President George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate; a private tour of the Scottish Rite's House of the Temple in Washington as well as a tour of the

West Wing of the White House and inner chambers of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. More to follow.

You should be encouraged that your lodge is breeding new life. As you know, we have two Entered Apprentices. They may have some company relatively soon because we had another petition for first reading at the October Stated. And, in a shocking turn of events, I was handed two completed petitions with fees as we were locking the Lodge up after Stated!!!

There were two notable special presentations at our October Stated. WBro. Jason Lotz was presented with his Life Membership in Perpetuity. Also, Bro. Samuel Turner bestowed a “proper” hat to the Worshipful Master of the Lodge with hopes that it will be passed down from Master to Master. The hat was procured from the Sherlock Holmes Museum in England. It is a fine hat and will be worn proudly! Thanks, Brother Turner.

Plans are still in the works to award two community builder awards; one for the Fairfax County Police Department and one for the Annandale Volunteer Fire Department. I am just waiting for the personnel nominations from each. We will visit each organization and make the presentation among their colleagues. Look for an announcement with the date and time. Please join me if within the length of your cabletow.

Calls will be going out shortly with Audit Committee assignments for the Annual Audit of the Lodge; Audit of the Timberman Temple Corporation; Audit of the Scholarship Committee; and Annual Trustee Report.

Thanks to the Timberman Temple Corporation (TTC) for their tireless support to the Lodge. They arranged for a much needed facelift for our parking lot. They are also facilitating a matter that might prove to be a topic of great importance for the Lodge, particularly as we are approaching the precipice of identifying the future state of our membership, which might also require consideration of a change in our meeting location. Absolutely NOTHING is set in stone at this time and what follows is very notional and the concepts are in their infancy.

A leader in the local Korean community contacted me to discuss options of working with ETL54 and the TTC to have a Korean Cultural Community Center in the area. The TTC agreed that we should meet with the POC as a group. The POC shared his vision with the TTC and representatives of Faith Chapter OES and Elmer Timberman Trustees on 10 October 2019. The aim of the initiative is to duplicate the theme of a Jewish Community Center in the area. It would be a means for Koreans to have a central place to meet and support the culture in the community. Annandale has a long history as being a hub for Koreans in the Northern Virginia area and DC. There are 11 general community centers in Fairfax County and it is not enough. The organization would like to know if we are open to selling our building outright or enter into some building use agreement to facilitate the endeavor. The TTC requested a copy of their business proposal to bring before the Lodge. It has also come to our attention that the Hispanic churches that rent our Social Hall has expressed a desire to purchase our building. Again, to our members, these are only discussions at this time. While they are early discussions, please keep in mind that Lodge leadership must be prudent and balance the various pros and cons for any potential future state given the current level of member participation at Lodge. I am open to phone calls if you would like to know more of the discussions prior to offering any input you might have.

Finally, brethren, dinner preceding our Stated Communications starts at 6:30PM and Lodge opens at 7:30PM. As usual, Faith Chapter OES provides a lovingly prepared meal for us. Please come and enjoy the fare and fellowship.

### **MASONIC EDUCATION**

WHY WE MEET. We meet for the purpose of admitting members to our fellowship, to instruct them in the lessons and principles (of Masonry) and to strengthen each other in adherence thereto, said George W. 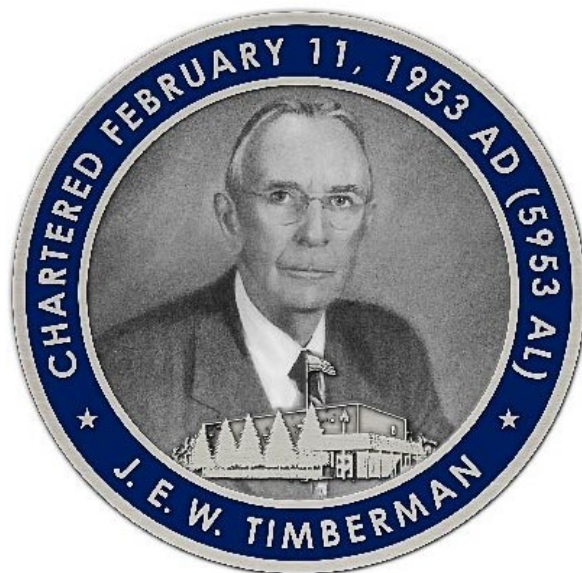
