Carl Joseph Stier, 78, of Sebewaing, passed away Sunday, June 8, 2003, at Tendercare of Cass City. He was born in Indianapolis, Ind. on March 28, 1925, son of the late Leo and Alma (Spitznagle) Stier. He served with the United States Army as a medic in the European Theater during World War II. On Aug. 16, 1947, he was united in marriage to Luella E. Kuehn at Bowling Green, Ohio. She preceded him in death on Aug. 13, 1995. Mr. Stier worked as an engineer with the Chrysler Corporation in Highland Park for 40 years. He retired and moved to Huron County in 1987.
