We collaborate with other churches and groups who provide assistance in Montgomery County and cooperate with groups in the diocese as well as other SSVdP conferences. Most of our assistance is with utility bills—electricity, water, heating—but individual needs vary greatly. If we cannot provide the aid, we work to find someone or some agency that can.

Parish members and community members have been generous in donations of furnishings which we distribute as individuals present their needs. Thankfully, storage space has also been donated. The community has several food banks for which we collect periodically. Reverend Guffie is organizing a Community Garden in the lot next to the SSVdP Office. Volunteers are needed there.
