- Our semi-annual "annual" meeting is Sunday, November 20th, following the 10:45 worship service; we will be electing new church council members and getting a preview of the 2017 budget;
- A mid-week Advent Contemplative Bible Study and Responsive Prayer Service will begin on Wednesday, November 30th, 7-8pm, and run through Wednesday, December 21st;
- A revamped "Sunday School" will begin on the last Sunday, November 27th, which is also 1st Advent, the first Sunday of the liturgical year Keiki Church. Stay tuned;
- The Cubs or the Indians will win the World Series.

Ever skip a text message from someone? Nope, me, either. I read them all.


So ... in an effort to get the really important news and reminders to you without cluttering up your life, we here at Christ Lutheran Church will be beta-testing some text message services.
