

**ORDINANCE NO. 72**

**AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION ON JANUARY 16, 1999  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY OFFICIAL FOR THE CITY  
OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LOG CABIN CITY COUNCIL.**

**SECTION I.**

**AN ELECTION IS HEREBY ORDERED TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF LOG CABIN,  
TEXAS ON JANUARY 16, 1999 SAME BEING THE THIRD SATURDAY IN JANUARY,  
BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. AND 7:00 P.M. ELECTION TO BE HELD AT CITY  
HALL FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE FOLLOWING OFFICIAL: ONE (1)  
COUNCILPERSON FOR AN UNEXPIRED TERM (15 MONTHS).**

**SECTION II.**

**THAT LOUISE RICHARDSON IS HEREBY APPOINTED PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE  
ELECTION AND THAT IVAN PEEBLES IS APPOINTED ALTERNATE JUDGE. THE  
PRESIDING ELECTION JUDGE IS GRANTED AUTHORITY TO APPOINT AS MANY  
ELECTION CLERKS AS DEEMED NECESSARY TO PROPERLY CONDUCT SAID  
ELECTION WITHOUT PRIOR OR SUBSEQUENT APPROVAL OR RATIFICATION BY  
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS.**

**SECTION III.**

**THAT THE OFFICIAL BALLOT OF SAID ELECTION OF JANUARY 16, 1999 SHALL  
SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLY WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS GOVERNING  
MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.**

**SECTION IV.**

**THAT ONLY QUALIFIED VOTERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE AT SAID  
ELECTION, IN THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS.**

**SECTION V.**

**THAT SHIRLEY TOWNSEND IS HEREBY APPOINTED CLERK FOR EARLY VOTING.  
THE EARLY VOTING SHALL BE HELD AT 14387 ALAMO ROAD, LOG CABIN, TEXAS.  
EARLY VOTING SHALL BE 9:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M. EACH DAY WITH THE EXCEPTION  
OF SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS AND OFFICIAL STATE HOLIDAYS. EARLY VOTING  
SHALL BEGIN AT 9:00 A.M. ON DECEMBER 28, 1998 AND END AT 5:00 P.M. ON  
JANUARY 12, 1999.**

SECTION VI.

THAT NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION SHALL BE PUBLISHED IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION, PUBLISHED IN HENDERSON COUNTY. SAID PUBLICATION SHALL NOT BE LESS THAT TEN (10) NOR MORE THAN THIRTY (30) DAYS BEFORE THE ELECTION. THE MAYOR IS HEREBY INSTRUCTED TO CAUSE SUCH NOTICE TO BE GIVEN.
