Safe Technology

- Work with CTO on removing clickthroughs that incorrectly assign responsibility for data use.

- Began series of meetings over the summer with MCPS Chief Legal Counsel about better informing parents about what electronic learning platforms are used prior to deploying them in the classroom; deleting personal identifying information where appropriate; teacher trainings on FERPA and COPPA.
