

2019 Challenge Competition SDSGA & SDSU Wool Project

Competition will be held at the SDSGA convention
Sept 27-28, 2019 in Spearfish, SD.

General Information

Contest is open to anyone ~ individual or team.

Contest entries must be primarily constructed using SDSU Wool Project fabric &/or yarn remnants, but may also utilize other materials.

Items may be anything (really!) ~ limited only by your imagination!

Signature wool remnants are limited in size & quantity ~ and **any** remnants not used **must** be returned to the SDSGA.

Be one of the artists to “dress a SDSU bunny” using the Signature Wool remnants. A few bunnies are available on a first come basis (limited quantities available) and you can make a sweater, dress, hat & tie, costume, anything for the bunny. Bunnies from the 2018 needle-felting workshop are eligible for a special award this year - so bring your bunny & needle-felted outfit back for display.



Prizes will be awarded based on creativity, construction, and wool promotion. Items must be labeled securely with name and contact information of the artist.

Contest items may be delivered to any district contest, or to Patty DeZeeuw at 619-5th Ave, Brookings, SD. Entry deadline is September 27th.

Winners will be announced at the SDSGA/MIWW banquet ~ Sept 28, 2019.

All items entered (except needle-felted bunnies from 2018) will be auctioned at the convention or sold at the SD Art Museum or the Ag Heritage Museum with all funds going to the SDSU Signature Wool Project Scholarships. Contest participants will receive cash awards, a free ticket to the Welcome Reception event, and will be recognized at the auction.
