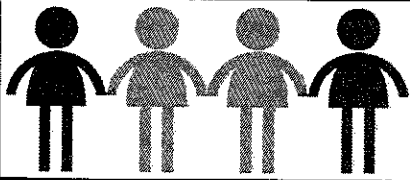

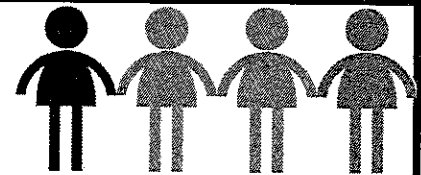

## SPRING HAS SPRUNG!

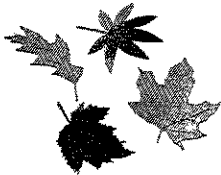
With the increase in rain we are seeing our grass start to grow again and weeds flourish. Oak Hollow require lawns to be kept no higher than 6 inches.

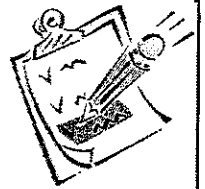

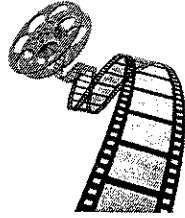

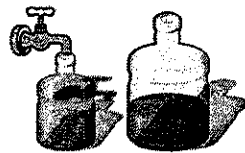
